1 RULES

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 The Annual One Design regatta is open to the following invited classes Flying Scot, Front Runner, Laser, Laser Radial, San Juan 21, 505, Optimist Dinghy (Red, Blue, White and Green fleets), Hampton One Design, and Windmill, and any other one-design class, with 5 or more boats registered, are invited to race.
- 2.2 Eligible Flying Scots will be racing and scored in the Flying Scot Capital District Championship.
- 2.3 A minimum of five entries is required for a class to become and remain eligible.
- 2.4 Classes shall meet eligibility requirements no later than August 1, 2020.
- 2.5 Invited classes not meeting the 5 boat minimum required for an individual start will be started and scored in a Portsmouth Handicap fleet.
- 2.6 Additional classes may be added at the discretion of FBYC.
- 2.7 Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with class rules.
- 2.8 All pre-registered competitors are required to check in at the check in table upon their arrival at the club not later than 0925 on the first day of the regatta.
- 2.8 All entries MUST be registered by Saturday, August 8, 2020 at 0900.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at check-in and online at www.fbyc.net by August 07, 2020.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The racing areas for adult classes will be on the Piankatank River between Fishing Bay and Godfrey Bay on the North and South and Gwynn's island to the east.
- 6.2 The racing areas for junior classes will be in Fishing Bay.
- 6.3 Hand-launched boats may use ample ramp and beach facilities. Trailered boats will be put in by tractor or may use the hoist on the North side of the property in Jackson Creek.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One completed race shall constitute the regatta. The Flying Scot Capital District Championship will be limited to a maximum of five (5) races.
- 7.2 Low-point scoring will apply with the exception of no throw-outs. This changes RRS A4.

8 AWARDS

- 8.1 Annual One Design Awards will be given to the first 3 finishers in each class.
- 8.2 The John R. Hawksworth Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the class winner who has been most competitive as measured both by the degree to which he has consistently been at the top of his class and the number of boats against which he has competed.

9 Discipline

All competitors are expected to maintain the highest level of conduct throughout the entire event. When the Protest Committee, from its own observation or a report received from any source believes that a competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute, it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under RRS 69.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
