1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to the Hobie 20, Hobie 18, Hobie 17, Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, Formula 18 Class, A Class Catamaran classes and Weta Class Multihulls.
- 2.2. At the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority, other Multihull one design classes under 21 feet may petition to participate if a minimum of three (3) boats are registered by the end of the normal registration period.
- 2.3. One competitor on each Hobie Class boat must be a member of the Hobie Class Association of North America.
- 2.4. All boats must comply with their class rules at all times during the regatta.
- 2.5. Eligible boats must enter by completing the online entry form at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20921>.
- 2.6. Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver may be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Registration entry fee is \$60 for double-handed boats and \$55 for single-handed boats if received before or on July 16, 2020. Youth skippers under 18 deduct \$20 from the entry fee if received before or on July 16, 2020.
- 3.2. The late entry fee is \$90 for double-handed boats and \$80 for single-handed boats for entries after July 16, 2020.
- 3.3. Notice of Parking and Launching providing instructions regarding vehicles and passes, launching, trailer and boat parking will be posted at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20921>
- 3.4. Competitors and guests will need to purchase parking and trailer passes to park and launch at Santa Cruz Harbor. Vehicles and trailers not displaying a pass or not parked in the designated areas may be ticketed by the Santa Cruz Harbormaster.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Competitor briefing is scheduled outdoors for July 18, 2020 at 1100 hours near the boat park at the hoist
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.3. No races will be started after 1600 hours Sunday July 19, 2020
- 4.4. Up to nine (9) races are scheduled in the Regatta.
- 4.5. One (1) race will constitute a regatta
- 4.6. On Saturday July 18, 2020 after racing, an outdoor BBQ is planned. Details will be e-mailed to the competitors
- 4.7. Awards presentation is planned on Sunday, July 19, 2020 following racing. Details will be e-mailed to the competitors

5. Sailing Instructions

6. Venue

- 6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7. Prizes

- 7.1. The number of prizes to be awarded will be at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on the number of normal registered competitors.

8. Risk, Disclaimer of Liability, and Personal Conduct

- 8.1. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk (see Rule 4, Decision to Race). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 8.2. Competitors will accept full responsibility for all their actions during any activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
