NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Joey Shepro Memorial Doublehanded Race Rules, which are part of the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 This is a jib and main race. No spinnaker use will be allowed.
- 1.3 This is a doublehanded race. Crew limit 2.
- 1.4 The race will be started using the PHRF "Pursuit" staggered start system
- 1.5 EACH BOAT MUST BE INSURED WITH THIRD PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE. Proof of insurance must be provided at entry.
- 1.6 <u>COVID-19: All participants must follow current CDC guidelines, as well as State of Michigan laws</u> and governor's orders, for social distancing and safe boating.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all seaworthy yachts.
- 2.2 Eligible yachts may enter by completing the registration form, providing their proof of insurance, and paying the required fee during the registration period.
- 2.3 Registration will be done exclusively online in order to comply with COVID-19 social distancing requirements.

One doublehanded class shall race.

4. FEES

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 <u>Registration</u>: Open immediately. Closes August 15, 2020 at 1000 sharp. No late registrations will be accepted. A REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE WITHOUT PROOF OF INSURANCE AND PAYMENT OF FEES.
- 5.2 <u>Skippers Meeting</u>: To be held online via Facebook Live at the MMYC Facebook page <u>https://www.facebook.com/officialmmyc</u> at 1100 on August 15, 2020.
- 5.3 <u>Warning</u>: August 15 at 1155. The first yacht will start at 1200.

6. MEASUREMENTS

Measurements will be handled per the Joey Shepro Memorial Doublehanded Race Rules. No handicap certificate is necessary.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSE

Sailing instructions will be provided at <u>http://www.mmyc.org/joey2020</u> before the skippers meeting. The course, generally, is 13.62 nm, starting in Menominee, around Green Island either way, returning to Menominee. The sailing instructions shall describe the course in detail.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 No onshore in-person events will take place in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- 8.2 Racing shall take place in the waters of the Bay of Green Bay.

9. SCORING

The race will be handicapped and scored per the Joey Shepro Memorial Doublehanded Race Rules.

10. PRIZES

Brag flags will be awarded to the top finishers and are distributed during the MMYC awards dinner in October. In the event this dinner must be cancelled, alternate means of awards delivery will be arranged.
