



Del Rey Yacht Club Single/Double Handed Series 2020

June 28, July 5, July 26 and August 9, August 23

Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

This is a fun and easy series to get us all back on the water!

Racing and Cruising class boats are invited to enter, with all entry fees being donated to a local food bank.

1 RULES

- 1.1 This series shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Yacht club membership is not required.
- 1.3 All double handed entries **SHALL BE CREWED BY PEOPLE THAT CURRENTLY LIVE UNDER THE SAME ROOF!** Any boat/crew not complying will be disqualified and excluded from the balance of this series.
- 1.4 For the purpose of safety, no spinnakers are allowed in this series.
- 1.5 For the purposes of safety, auto pilot and self steering systems may be used (this changes RRS 52).
- 1.6 Any change to these Sailing Instructions will be posted by 0900 each race day www.dryc.org . Oral instructions may be given on the water by the Race Committee (RC) before the first warning signal.

2 ENTRY & RATINGS

- 2.1 The entry fee is \$10.00 per race, which will be donated to a local food bank. The entry deadline is 1700 the day before each day. Enter at www.dryc.org under the racing tab.
- 2.2 Ratings will be based on PHRF of So. Cal. 2020 W/L ratings. PHRF membership is not required.

3 CLASSES, CLASS FLAGS AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Divisions will be established for PHRF and Cruising. If the RC finds an entry unsuitable for the Cruising division, it may be moved into the PHRF division.
- 3.3 Class splits, flags, and the order of starts will be posted no later than 0900 each race day, at www.dryc.org
- 3.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start each day is 1255 (multiple sound signals will be made 1 minute before).

4 COURSE AND MARKS

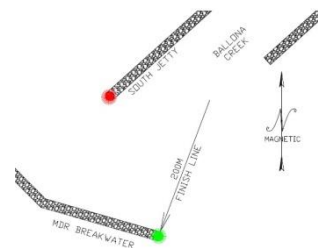
- 4.1 From the starting line:
Sail the course signaled by the RC (see Attachment A).

5 THE START

- 5.1 The starting line will be between SS mark and an orange flag on the RC boat (see MDR Course Chart 17).

6 THE FINISH

- 6.1 The finishing line begins at the Marina del Rey detached breakwater green light and continues through your helm position (see diagram). When the light bears 200°m, from your helm position, record your finish time. For safety purposes, this modifies the definition of *finish*.
- 6.2 All boats shall submit a completed Finish/Retirement form (Attachment B). The form shall be texted or emailed to the Sail Committee Chairman (see NOR/SI 11) no later than 1 hour after finishing.
- 6.3 A boat not finishing by 1730 will be scored DNF without a hearing (this changes RRS 35, A 4.2).



7 PROTESTS

- 7.1 Any boat intending to protest shall indicate this on the Finish/Retirement Form (Attachment B) and submit it to the Sail Committee Chairman (see NOR/SI 11) no later than 1 hour of finishing.
- 7.2 Protests shall be emailed to the Sail Committee Chairman by noon the day after the race (Protest Time Limit). Hearings will be held via Zoom at a later date to be announced.

8 SCORING

9 AWARDS

For Race #1 there will be no pre-race gathering or post-race party at the clubhouse. After each race, we will host a post-race awards and virtual Happy Hour on Zoom. We will text each participant the info.

10 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in these races entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4). By participating in these races, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors and any others acting in any official capacity for these races) from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Handicap distance: 8.5 nm

1. Leave DD Mark to Port
2. Leave 2ES to Port
3. Proceed to NOR/SI #6 (the Finish)

Course D

Handicap distance: 4.4 NM

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Proceed to NOR/SI #6 (the Finish)

Course B

Handicap distance: 7.8 nm

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Leave 2ES Mark to Port
3. Proceed to NOR/SI #6 (the Finish)

Course C

Handicap distance: 5.5 nm

1. Leave D Mark to Port
2. Leave BB Mark to Port
4. Proceed to NOR/SI #6 (the Finish)
