



Amendments made to the SI's

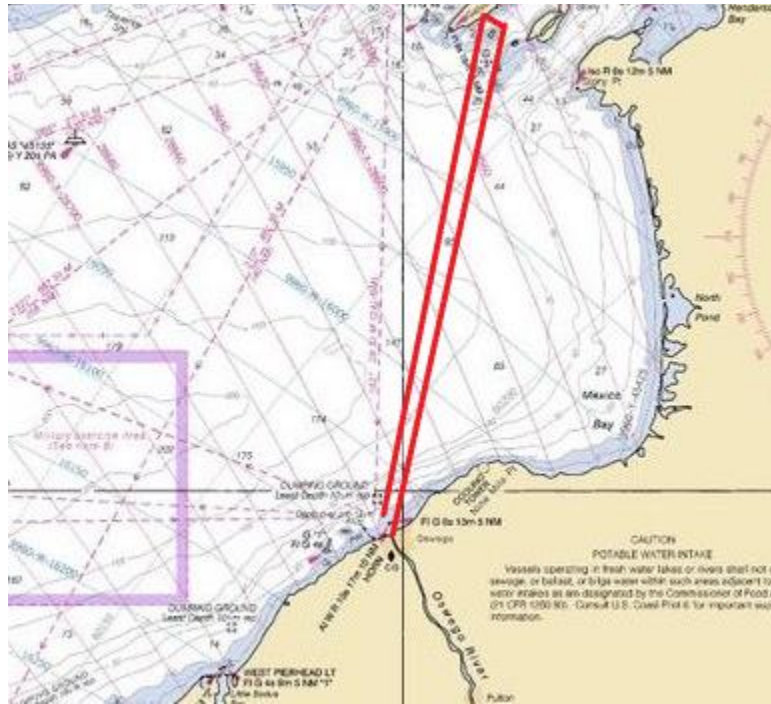
8.1 The diagram in the AMMENDED Appendix A illustrates the intended course. **Spinnaker and Genoa** Only boats shall sail the RED course depicted from start about .25NM northwest of Oswego Light House, then head north to round Little Galloo Island, taking the island to starboard, then returning to Oswego harbor to finish between the Red and Green channel markers in the Oswego river.

12.2 In the event of boats not being able to complete the race within the final time limit, the time taken at the Little Galloo Island rounding may be used to score some or all of the boats. All boats shall take their own GPS times when they are due north of Little Galloo island and make note of the position of any other boats in the vicinity.

14.2 The Finishing line for all divisions shall extend between the Oswego Rivers Red and Green channel markers.

14.3 Race Committee shall be on station for the start on Saturday ONLY. Competitors shall record their finish times when crossing between the channel markers, a GoPro camera will monitor the finish line to assist in accurate recording. In the absence of a committee boat on station US prescription to RRS 34 shall apply.

Appendix A



Additional Changes to the Awards

Awards Ceremony: Due to our current situation at OYC and the States Regulations on gathering in the midst of the Covid19 pandemic. We will suspend the typical post awards “Party” that would normally follow the race. Competitors are welcome to gather with their crews and practice social distancing after the race at the Gobel Dry Dock pavilion. Competitors may use the picnic tables, restrooms and grills as needed. Some other “amenities” will also be available after the race for the skippers and their crews.

Awards: Due to the length of this race not all competitors may finish before the original time in the NOR for the awards presentation. Therefore, we will issue the awards to the winning boats the following day (Sunday) before they depart for their home ports. If a winning boat is not present to receive their awards, arrangements will be made with that winning boat. For the LYRA trophy and Flag presentation, this will take place at their November meeting. Winners will be invited to come and pick up their awards, further information will be provided at a later date.
