GENERAL INFORMATION

This is a 13+ mile pursuit race; each boat will be assigned a start time in minutes after the slowest rated boat starts. The assigned start time is calculated by the Race Chair and is based on the boats Portsmouth Rating DPN and expected duration of the race.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is modified to require all competitors to wear personal floatation at all times except for short periods while changing clothes.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

- 2.1 The race is open to all centerboards boats of 20 feet or less with a Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less, and catamarans of 20 feet or less with a Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less.
- 2.2 Boats need to conform to class rules, including minimum and maximum crew weights and number of crew.
- 2.3 Exceptionally this year, keel boats are invited to race on the strict condition that they are double handed. These invited boats are not eligible to win the Outlook Trophy.

3. ENTRY AND FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$10.
- 3.2 Entries must be made online through www.regattanetwork.com by 0900, the day of the race. Competitors under the age of eighteen must have their entry signed by their parents or guardian.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1 Three or more one design boats will establish a one design class.
- 4.2 Classes are mono-hull centerboards (20 feet and under) and multi-hulls (20 feet and under).

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at www.sccyc.org web sites no later than 2000 hours on the Friday before the race.

- 8.1 The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, west of the Marina del Rey Breakwater.
- 8.2 Course will use both MDR Marks, described in Course Chart 17, and orange or yellow inflatable marks.
- 8.3 The course will be approximately 13 miles.

9. SERIES SCORING

Boats will be scored in the order of finish.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC some time in a better future.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

VHF Radios are encouraged for this ocean race. Race Committee (RC) will monitor channel 68.
