**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any classes providing at least three entries. Classes requesting a start should email [Triton499@gmail.com](mailto:Triton499@gmail.com) by Sunday 20 September 2020.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the CBYRA 2020 General Sailing Instructions found at: [http://www.cbyra.org/application/files/1515/8427/4100/2020\\_Green\\_Book.pdf](http://www.cbyra.org/application/files/1515/8427/4100/2020_Green_Book.pdf).

**Rendezvous:** At 0900 in vicinity of "77" FI G 2.5s (approximately 2 nm south of Cove Point).

**Radio:** Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

**Start:** Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and "77" FI G 2.5s or nearby inflatable mark.

The first warning signal is scheduled for 0930. Starting times, classes, and any additional class flags used by the Race Committee will be available by Amendment on the notice board [www.shearwatersc.net](http://www.shearwatersc.net) not later than 1700 on Friday 25 September, 2020.

**Signals:** RRS 26 "Starting Races".

**Course:** The Cove Point LNG Terminal, including its Safety Zone perimeter, must be left to port.

**Finish:** Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and West River G"1" FL G 4s. Course is 30.6 nm.

**Time Limit:** 1900 for all classes. Boats not finishing within two hours of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

**Scoring:** CRCA handicap ratings will be determined in coordination with CRCA representative.

**Protests:** Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 28 September 2020. Hearing at a time and place to be announced.

**Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup>/3, 2<sup>nd</sup>/5, 3<sup>rd</sup>/7 & 4<sup>th</sup>/10+ starters. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Race Committee.

**for COVID-19: All captains and crew should be fully aware that participation in this race may increase your exposure to COVID-19. Shearwater Sailing Club will not accept any liability for any**

illness or injury contracted as a result of participation in this race. This race may be held under modified conditions or cancelled depending on conditions related to COVID-19 as the date of the race approaches. Any rules or guidance related to social distancing will be stated by Amendment on the notice board [www.shearwatersc.net](http://www.shearwatersc.net) not later than 1700 on Friday 25 September 2020. In the meantime, captains should keep apprised of the current restrictions and guidelines regarding boating and social distancing in Maryland and be prepared to implement those on their vessel.
