



9.4. A boat starting later than 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" without hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

#### **10. THE FINISH**

10.1. The finish line will be between a staff displaying a yellow flag on the committee boat and a nearby yellow mark.

#### **11. PENALTY SYSTEM**

11.1. Rule 44.2, the two turns penalty shall apply.

#### **12. PROTEST AND REQUEST FOR REDRESS**

12.1. Any boat wishing to protest another boat must notify the protested boat of their intention to do so by hailing "Protest."

12.2. Protesting boat will notify the Race Committee of the protested boat's sail number as soon as reasonably possible following the finish of that race.

12.3. Notices will be posted over vhf no later than 30 minutes after the last finisher of the last race. To inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named witnesses. Hearing will be held on the water, in a 3 minute justice format..

#### **13. SCORING**

13.1. The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will be used.

13.2. The regatta for the Championship Fleet and Green Fleet will consist of up to 5 races.

13.3. One race will constitute a championship.

13.4. There will be 1 drop if at least 5 races are sailed. This modifies RRS A2.

#### **14. SAFETY REGULATIONS**

14.1. All participants must wear a USCG approved PFD while on the water and have a working whistle.

14.2. Any competitor leaving the racing area shall attempt to notify the Race Committee or, if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore. Failure to notify the race committee in a timely manner may result in disqualification for the day of racing.

#### **15. SUPPORT BOATS**

15.1. Team leaders, coaches, other support personnel and spectators shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for a race until all boats have finished that race, or until the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment

15.2. Coach/support and spectator boats shall follow the instructions of race committee and race management boats. Coach/support boats are responsible for helping **all** boats in distress.

15.3. All Support Boats must adhere to Social Distance Guidelines at ALL TIMES.

#### **16. PRIZES**

16.1. Trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and top 10 for each fleet, Red, Blue, White

16.2. Green Fleet will receive medals 1<sup>st</sup> thru 10<sup>th</sup> and all other sailors will receive participation ribbons.

#### **17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

17.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

See rule 4, Decisions to Race.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
