## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 All prescriptions of US Sailing will apply.
- 1.3 All competitors will be required to wear a properly fastened USCG-approved personal flotation device at all times except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Each competitor shall have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.

### 2.0 Eligibility

- 2.1 Boats of the following classes are eligible to enter: Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420.
- 2.2 All competitors (skippers and, where applicable, crew) shall not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday during calendar year 2009.
- 2.3 All competitors (skippers or crews) shall provide a release for medical care, which must be signed by a parent or guardian if under 18.

### 3.0 Entry, Check-in & Sailing Instruction Availability

- 3.1 Competitors are required to enter on-line via Regatta Network. On-line entry, including the payment of the entry fee, is at <a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet\_club\_events.php?CLUB\_ID=308">https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet\_club\_events.php?CLUB\_ID=308</a>. On-line entry closes at 18:00 on Friday, June 26.
- 3.2 Payment of the entry fee is required at the time of entry.
- 3.3 An entry is not complete until a representative of each boat has checked in at the Duxbury Bay Maritime School during the times listed in NOR 5.0.
- 3.4 Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in.

#### 4.0 Entry Fees and Payment

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$50 per boat for Lasers and \$100 per boat for Club 420s.
- 4.2 The entry fee includes a regatta T-shirt for entries received before June 17, 2009. T-shirts for entries received after June 17 will be subject to availability.
- 4.3 Entry fee includes an on-land rigging clinic and lunch before racing on Saturday and refreshments after racing on Sunday.

#### 5.0 Schedule

#### 6.0 Venue

- 6.1 The location of all regatta landside activities and launching area will be the Duxbury Bay Maritime School, 457 Washington St, Duxbury, MA.
- 6.2 The racing area for all classes will be Duxbury Bay.

#### 7.0 Scoring

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's series score will exclude her worst race score if five or more races are completed.

#### 8.0 Boat Identification

- 8.1 Identification on sails must comply with the RRS, except for chartered, loaned, or club boats, which must carry a unique, clearly visible, legible sail number. Such sail number must be provided to the regatta registrars at check-in.
- 8.2 A boat may not change her sail number during the regatta unless specifically approved by the Race Committee.

#### 9.0 Safety and Adult Responsibility

- 9.1 An adult (Parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each sailor under the age of 18. It is the responsibility solely of this adult to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 9.2 Parents and guardians not personally attending any part of the event shall ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor, and each competitor shall indicate in writing the parent or adult representative that will be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.

9.3 The designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

#### 10.0 Support boats

- 10.1 All visiting coach boats are required to register with the regatta registrars at check in time.
- 10.2 Each coach boat shall have a working VHF radio, an anchor suitable for anchoring in the waiting area, and a basic first aid kit.

#### 11.0 Prizes

11.1 Regatta prizes will be awarded to first through third places in each class with 10 or more boats. Classes with 5 or less boats will have a first place prize only.
