Notice of Race

2010 Commodores Regatta

Sunday March 28, 2010

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. RRS 26 will be changed. The race will be started in a reverse handicap with boats starting at a specified time according to her PHRF rating.
- 1.3. RRS 29 will be changed.
- 1.4. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.5. Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. Boats holding a valid 2010 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register at [Regatta Network](#) or by filling out the 2010 Commodores Regatta Entry Form and presenting it to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club before 1055 March 14, 2010

3. Fees

- 3.1. The online entry fee is \$35. Online registration will close March 27, 2010.
- 3.2. The early entry fee is \$35. Boats may register early by presenting a completed 2010 Commodores Regatta Entry Form and paying the entry fee to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club by 2000 on March 27, 2010.
- 3.3. The regular entry fee is \$45. Boats may register by presenting a completed 2010 Commodores Regatta Entry Form and paying the entry fee to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club between 1000 and 1055 on March 27, 2010.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Registration will be March 28, 2010 between 1000 and 1055 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 4.2. There will be a competitors briefing March 28, 2010 at 1100 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 4.3. There is one race scheduled for March 28, 2010.
- 4.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal March 28, 2010 is 1255.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions, including course to be sailed and start times for each entry, will be available no later than 1100 on March 28, 2010 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club and posted on the club website.

6. Venue

- 6.1. Racing will be around buoy enclosed courses, between Capitola and Natural Bridges in an area approximately 2.5 miles radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7. Divisions and Prizes

- 7.1. Racing will be in the following divisions: A fleet (PHRF < 89), B fleet (PHRF > 89), Double-Handed, Jib & Main < 182, Jib & Main > 182.
- 7.2. Prizes will be awarded in these divisions and based upon entries at the discretion of the organizing authority.
