Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in ISAF 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 The Appendix P of the RRS will apply.
- 1.3 **Clean Water.** Boats shall not put trash in the water. Trash may be placed aboard support and race committee boats. Their disposal at sea may be a reason to elimination or other penalty measures instructed on the Racing Instructions.

2 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND VENUE

- 2.1 The Organizing Authority is the CLUB NÁUTICO MAR DEL PLATA in conjunction with the Argentinean Skiff Association (ASA).
- 2.2 **Boat Park.** All boats shall stay at the venue of the Championship from the first day of scheduled races until the end of the protests on the last racing day of the event.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee of \$ 200 (Argentine Pesos) per boat, to be pay at the Club Nautico Mar del Plata.
- 3.2 Parent/Guardian Declarations: All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration. Participants from Argentina under 21 years old must also comply with the Limited Responsibility Rules published by the Federación Argentina de Yachting (FAY) on its website <http://www.fay.org.ar/Menoresaut/faymenoraut.doc>

4 RACING ZONE AND COURSES

- 4.1 The Racing Zone will be on the near bound areas of the port. Further description will be given on the Racing Instructions.
- 4.2 The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward courses of 4 or 6 legs. Further instructions will be given on the Racing Instructions.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Monday, December 27th12Hs.....Race
Tuesday, December 28th11Hs....Race
Wednesday, December 29th11 Hs....Race

For the present championship there are 9 races schedule and it will be valid with the finish races until the last day of the championship. When 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. With 9 races completed, a boat score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst two.
