Sailing Instructions

- 1) This regatta is governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing(RSS) 2009-1012
- 2) The regatta is open to all current J/105 class members. Boats will be subject to class and local fleet crew weight, crew classification and sail declaration. Any crew members who have not weighed-in during the 2011 season will be required to weigh-in on Saturday 7/30/11 between 8:30 and 10:00 AM. Registration and payment can be made at <http://race.coronadoyc.org> or in person at CYC on Saturday morning from 0900 to 0945.
- 3) Notices ashore will be posted on the RC bulletin board on the CYC front porch. Any visual signals ashore will be on the club flag pole located on the CYC roof.
- 4) There will be a skipper's meeting at 1000 on the front porch of CYC. The races will be started using RRS 26. The start will be in the vicinity of San Diego Bay Buoys 28/30. The RC will attempt to hail boats over early on channel 68 VHF.
- 5) The schedule of races is as follows: On Saturday, 3 races are scheduled with no scored race starting after 3:00 PM

Following the third race there will be a fun "Race to the Barn". This race will NOT be scored as part of the regatta total. On Sunday, 2 races are scheduled with no race starting after 3:00 PM.

- 6) The starting class flag will be designated at the skippers meeting.
- a. The weather mark will be an orange tetrahedron. The change mark will be a yellow tetrahedron. The start line is between an orange flag on the port side of the RC boat and a yellow tetrahedron. The finish is on the starboard side of the RC boat between a green flag and a yellow tetrahedron.
 - b. The offset buoy at the weather mark will be a small red fender ball.
 - c. The leeward gate will be large red fender balls.
 - d. The course number will be displayed on a white board, hung fore and aft on the RC boat.
 - e. Course to the weather mark will be displayed on a board, athwartships, at the stern of the RC boat.
- 7) The “Race to the Barn” is Course #4 on the enclosed Course Chart. The additional marks for this race include San Diego Bay Buoy 28 (SD28), Glorietta Bay Buoys 1 & 8 (GB1, GB 8), DIVER (a yellow tetrahedron located near the Boat House Restaurant close to the CYC Clubhouse). The Club Finish is between a barber pole painted piling at end of CYC B Dock and an orange flag pin. Skippers are advised to review the San Diego Bay Chart located in the CYC bar to identify shallow areas in Glorietta Bay.
- 8) Protests must be filed within one hour after the RC boat docks. The use of binding arbitration is authorized if agreed to by the competitors.
- 9) A total of 5 races are scheduled. One race constitutes a regatta. The time limit for each race is 1 and ½ hours. The last competitor in each class must finish within 20 minutes of the first place boat or be scored as a DNF. RSS 44 is changed to require only one turn including one take and one gybe.
- 10) The low point scoring system of Appendix A will be used to score the regatta with the exception that there will be no throw-outs and that each boats total score will be the sum of all races except the “Race to the Barn”.
