



**NOTICE OF RACE  
CAROLINA YACHT CLUB  
2012 EASTER REGATTA  
April 6 & 7, 2012**

**1. RULES**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**2. Racing rules will be changed as followed:**

2.1 All races will be scored except there will be one throw out if six races are sailed. This changes Appendix A2.

2.2 E-Scows will be required to race with Float Paks at the top of the mast.

**3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

3.1 The regatta is open to E-Scows, MC Scows and Lasers.

3.2 Laser class boats may register and sail as Laser Full, Radial or 4.7. A boat must sail the regatta in the rig as registered.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form, which is attached and will be available at registration.

**4. FEES:**

*Entry fees:	MC's and Lasers	\$80 (Juniors \$40)
	E-Scows	\$150

\* E-Scows get 4 party tickets. MC's and Lasers will get one ticket. Extra tickets are \$30 each.

**6. SOCIAL:**

- d. Boathouse and club restaurant are open to sailing participants and guests for the weekend (cash accepted). Appropriate attire required for the Club restaurant.

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

**8. VENUE:** Racing will be in beautiful Charleston harbor, from the Carolina Yacht Club, 50 East Bay Street, Charleston, South Carolina.

**9. THE COURSES:** The courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

**10. PENALTY SYSTEM:** RRS 44.1 (two turns penalty) is in effect except for the E-Scow class where RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

**11. SCORING:**

11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except that a boat's final score shall be the sum of all races, with no throw outs (except there will be one throw out if 6 races are sailed). This changes Rule A2.

11.2 Six races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.

**12. AWARDS:** Prizes will be awarded to first through fifth, depending on size of fleet.

**13. REGISTRATION:** Registration form is attached or available at registration.
