Notice of Race

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Open 5.70 one-design class rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal flotation device while racing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all Open 5.70 boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form online, or at the South Beach Yacht Club by April 20th before 1800 hours.

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 There must be at least 6 Open 5.70 registered with payment by April 20, 2011 for this regatta to take place.
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$80.00 if registration is received by April 20, 2011 at 1800 hours.
- 3.3 Late Entry fee is \$95.00 for registration after the deadline. Late registration will close by 0900, Saturday, April 21, 2012.
- 3.4 Registration packages for online registrants will be available for pick-up from a designated Fleet Representative between 0800 – 0900 at the Club.
- 3.5 Appertizers & snacks will be served after Sunday's racing, at the prize giving.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on-line on the SBYC website www.southbeachyc.org and at the SBYC office by 1800 hours on Thursday April 18, 2012.

6.0 RACE AREA

- 6.1 The intended race area is in the South Bay between Alameda and San Francisco. The Race Committee reserves the right to change the race area based on wind condition.

7.0 SCORING

- 7.1 One race shall constitute a series.
- 7.2 Seven races are scheduled. After six races are completed, one race (a seventh race) will be considered a throw-out, and not count towards a yacht's final score.

8.0 BERTHING

- 8.1 Berthing will be available at the SBYC guest docks for the regatta. Please refer to the attached documents. Slip assignments will be sent to racers prior to the day of the race.

9.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

SOUTH BEACH HARBOR Marina Info

Check-in

Upon arrival, boats owners should first tie up to their assigned slip and then check-in with Lisa Gidley at South Beach Yacht Club. Access to SBYC and the harbor office is through **Gate #2**. Use intercom to be “buzzed in.”

Power

- Odd numbered (north) slips on A-Dock have 50-amp/120v service. All other slips have 30-amp/120v service. 50-30 amp pigtail adapters are available in the office (with a \$150.00 credit card authorization/deposit).
- The A-end tie has two outlets: one 30-amp/120v service; one 120/250v service.
- Our Guest Docks (north and south) have 50-amp 120/250v service. We do have adapter to step down to both 50/120v or 30/120v. Ask at the front desk for help (a credit card deposit is also authorization/required).

Showers/Locker Rooms

They are located on the marina side of the building, lower level, just to the left of the main doors. A card key is required for entry.

Dock Carts

Are also located on the marina side of the building, lower level, just to the left of the Shower/Locker Rooms. A card key is required for entry

Parking

Online registrants will receive reserved parking passes in their registration packet from the designated Fleet Representative on Saturday. Additional parking passes can be purchased at SBYC. Because of space limitations, guest parking availability is at the discretions of the Harbor Office and determined on a daily basis.

IN GENERAL: on days when there is no Giants home game, holiday or special event, each reservation holder may purchase one parking permit at the office for \$20.00 per day, April 1 – October 31 (\$10.00 per day November 1 – March 31). Permits are issued at the Harbor Office. It is generally a good idea to call and inquire about parking availability before arriving.
