NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in ***The Racing Rules of Sailing*** updated January 2010, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

- 1.1 Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows:
The use of powered winches is authorized.
- 1.2 Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will not be restricted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations. Eligible boats may be entered at <http://www.waikikiyachtclub.com/RE/2012-Regatta-Information.aspx> by the entry deadline of 1800 Wed. 23 May 2012.

4 CLASSES

Boats will be scored in PH A, B, C & Multihull.
All three races count for HYRA season's points.

\$135 or \$130 for US SAILING member.

Day 1 – Waikiki to Kaneohe

Day 2 – Kaneohe to Kaena Point

Day 3 – Ko'Olina to Waikiki

10 SCORING

RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

11 MOORING

As a condition of Ko'Olina offering slips for this race, they require payment to WYC at or before the skippers meeting. Their slip fee is \$1.57 per foot per day. Payment must be by cash or check only.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for PH A, B, C & Multihull.
