NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The rules of J/120 Fleet Five and J/105 Fleet One will be in effect for those respective classes. Also in effect will be the International Melges 24 Class Rules 2012, bylaws and interpretations.
- 1.2 RRS 44.1 will be changed to agree with the Class Rules of individual classes. The changes will be described in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: J/120, J/105, Express 37, and Melges 24
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at <u>www.sfyc.org</u>.

2.3 The entry fee is \$85 for members of US SAILING and \$90 for non-members, if received by June 6, 2012. A \$25 late fee will be assessed after June 6.

2.4 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by June 6, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after June 7, 2012, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, <u>www.sfyc.org</u>.

- **5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:** The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.
- **6. COMMUNICATIONS:** The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.
- 7. SCORING: Five (5) races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series.
- 8. ARBITRATION: Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.
- 9. DOCKAGE: The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 8 through June 10.
- **10. PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
