NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is Grande Maumelle Sailing Club (GMSC)
- 1.2. The current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*) shall apply
- 1.3. The Rules of each individual class associations will apply for that class.
- 1.4. Advertising shall only be done in accordance with the ISAF Regulation 20.
- 1.5. Competitors are encouraged to bring their own boats. A limited number of boats may be available, but cannot be guaranteed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Applicants for all classes must not turn 22 years old in the year of the event.
- 2.2. Membership in US Sailing is required for each competitor (helmsman and crew). Competitors may sign up at registration.
- 2.3. Two boats in the same class will constitute a separate one-design Class for this regatta.
- 2.4. US Sailing recommends that competitors are members of their respective class associations.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

4. SCORING

- 4.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 (*RRS*) shall apply
- 4.2. One race will constitute a series. One race result will be thrown out for every four races completed.

5. COACHES

- 5.1. Coaches are asked to register at the event and will be recognized accordingly.

6. SAFETY

- 6.1. A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times while launching and when sailing.

7. DISCIPLINE

- 7.1. All competitors are expected to maintain the highest level of conduct throughout the entire event. GMSC Regatta Chairman or Race Committee officers, from its own observation or a report received from any other source, believes that a competitor may have committed a breach of a rule, good manners, or sportsmanship, or may have brought the sport into disrepute, it may call a hearing. After a proper hearing the penalty may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta and additional action may be taken under *RRS* 69.
- 7.2. Hearings will be held generally in accordance with the recommendations of Appendix M5 of the *RRS*.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. USA Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in all divisions. Additional awards will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.
