NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Eligibility

The Regatta is open to all eligible boats in the following classes:

Classes

- Opti's: Red, Blue, White, & Green
 - 420's
 - Laser, Laser 4.7, and Laser Radial
 - Open Bic

- All sailors must be a participant in a sailing program and must not have reached their 18th birthday as of December 31, 2011 to be eligible to compete.
 - A minimum of 8 boats may be required for a One-Design start.

3. Registration

- **Registration deadline is Friday, August 3, 2011, after which a \$40 late fee will be charged. No registration will be accepted after 12:00 noon on Wednesday, August 10. Walk-ins will not be accepted on the day of the regatta.**
- Registration and Medical Consent Forms are available to download at www.hyannisyachtclub.org and must be completed, and payment received, in order for entry to be considered complete.
- Fee: \$40 per person. There will be no refunds after Monday, August 6, 2012. Lunch will be provided for all competitors.
- Sailing Instructions will be available at check in.

4. Schedule of Events

Check-in: 8:00 – 9:00

Skippers Meeting: 9:00

Harbor Start: 9:30

Awards: As soon as possible after the conclusion of racing.

5. Scoring

- The Low Point Scoring System will apply.
- As many races as practical will be run during this regatta.
- A boat's series score will exclude her worst race only if five or more races are competed.
- One race constitutes a series.

6. Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded in each fleet except Opti Green fleet, where participation medals will be awarded.
- Prizes for sportsmanship may also be awarded.
