Notice of Race

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Stockton Sailing Club, 4980 Buckley Cove Way, Stockton, CA 95219, 209-951-5600. The Venue is the San Joaquin River adjacent to the Stockton Sailing Club facility.
- 1.3 Rules that will be changed are:

A2 will be changed by NOR11.3. If 5 or less races are completed there will be no discardable races.

A4.1 will be changed by Sailing Instructions to read that a boat may not start later than 5 minutes after her start signal.

35 and 4.1 will be changed by Sailing Instructions. There will be time limits.

40 shall be changed by Sailing Instructions to require personal floatation at all times while racing except for short times in order to adjust or change clothing.

1.4 All entrants shall start and finish together and be scored as a single fleet. Competitors may choose Standard, Radial or 4.7 rigs at their discretion, provided that all rig changes are made on shore and all sails have the same number (Rig-Swapping Rule turned on).

2 Language

The official language for this regatta will be English.

3 Inspection and Measurement

- 3.1 Sails may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. - 3.2 Masters shall display supplied colored tape wrapped around the mast immediately below the gooseneck and as close to it a possible. These bands shall be colored according to ILCA Masters identification requirements which is Green—Apprentice, Red—Master, Blue—Grand Master, Yellow—Great Grand Master
- 3.3 All boats shall have in place a tow line at least 20' long and at least 1/4inch diameter.

4 Eligibility and Entry

Competitors who are members of the International Laser Class Association and who have reached the age indicated in the categories below by regatta start date are eligible to compete. Competitors, who are not members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority.

4.1 Masters shall be divided into the following categories:

Apprentice – 35-44 years of age Master – 45-54 years of age Grand Master – 55-64 years of age Great Grand Master – 65+ years of age

4.2 Category shall be determined by **competitor's** age on regatta start date.

5 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7 Advance Registration

- 7.1 Competitors may register in advance by completing the standard ILCA-NA registration form and all other required forms. Entry on the internet is required unless this would present a hardship to a competitor. - 7.2 If the internet is not available to a competitor they may send all required forms and fees to Stockton Sailing Club, Attn: Laser PCCs, 4980 Buckley Cove Way Stockton, CA 95219. Make checks payable to "Stockton Sailing Club". Any mail in entries must be received by Monday, August 6, 2012. Late entries may be made on the first day of the regatta and must include the required late fee.

8 Fees

- 8.1 Required Fees: Advance registration fee is \$60.00; Registration on the day of the regatta is \$85.00.
- 8.2 The entry fee includes dinner Friday, breakfast Saturday, dinner Saturday night, and breakfast Sunday, plus a commemorative t-shirt. Please specify size S, M, L, XL, 2XL
- 8.3 Extra food packets may be purchased for the Regatta. These will include all food service available to the competitors for \$25 per packet.

10 Courses & Racing Area

- 10.1 Courses will be standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Masters Regatta Guidelines.
- 10.2 The racing area will be the waters to the South of the Stockton Sailing Club clubhouse.

11 Scoring

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 11.2 10 races are scheduled, a minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 11.3 If 6 races are completed a competitor may discard their worst score. This changes RRS A2.
- 11.4 NA Master handicap system will be in place. You add the following points to each race to find the overall series winner. Apprentices add 3 points Masters add 2 points Grand Masters add 1 point Great Grand Masters add 0 points The results are recalculated and the person with the lowest score wins, etc.
