**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing as updated January 2010*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, the Notice of Race and these Sailing Instructions.

- 1.2** Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows:  
The use of powered winches is authorized.

**2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the WYC card room.

**3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

**4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the WYC flagpole.

**5. SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAGS**

Skippers' Meeting: 0930 Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup> 2012  
The warning signal for the first race will be at 10:25 Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup> 2012.  
Races 2 & 3 will follow approx. 5 min after last finish in previous race.  
The class flag is:

PH                      Black with 1

## **6. RACING AREA**

The racing area will be ½ to 1 ½ mile off Ala Wai channel.

## **7. COURSES and MARKS**

The courses will be:

Course 1 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port and finish.

Course 2 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port, Mark 1 to port and finish.

Course 3 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port and finish.

The course will be signaled with the display of the corresponding numeral pennant.

Marks 1 and 2 will be inflatable orange tetrahedrons.

See attached map for course location and configuration.

## **8. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES**

The starting and finishing line will be between two yellow inflatable tetrahedrons.

## **9. TIME LIMIT**

The time limit for each race will be one hour for the first boat to finish.

## **10. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS**

Protests shall be delivered to WYC within 45 min. after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing at WYC.

## **11. SCORING**

All scores will count. One race constitutes a series.

## **12. PRIZES**

Awards will be at WYC after the races are scored.
