

2012 FALL SCORE/ DOUBLE HANDED SERIES

AUGUST 19, SEPTEMBER 23, AND OCTOBER 28, 2012

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the 2010-2011 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 4 races for PHRF and category 5 races for the double handed division.
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to any boat holding a valid 2012 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- There will be the following divisions: A fleet (PHRF < 88), B Fleet (PHRF > 89), Double Handed, Jib & Main (PHRF < 181) and Jib & Main (PHRF>182). Double handed division shall have exactly two persons on board. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at Regatta Network at: http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/5707 or scyc.org.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Regular entry fee is \$75 if received by 2000 hours August 18, 2012.
- 3.2 Late entry fee is \$90.00 if received after 2000 hours August 18, 2012.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 Late registration: 1000 hours to 1025 hours on August 19, 2012 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2 A competitors meeting will be at 1030 hours on August 19, 2012 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1225 hours each race day.
- 4.4 Six races are scheduled. There will be two races each day.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting and may be posted on line at scyc.org.

6 Venues

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending five miles off shore.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 8.2 Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the series are eligible for the 2012 Cliff McNamara Invitational Champion of Champions Regatta.

9. Disclaimer of Liability

9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The SCYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
