- 1. Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 2. Classes: This is a one-design regatta for mono-hull sailboats. Four boats shall constitute a class.
- 3. Berthing: If you wish to tow your one-design boat behind your big boat to Blackbeard and sleep on your big boat, a limited amount of free slips are available at Blackbeard Sailing Club on a first-come, first-served basis.
