Notice of Race

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

For each race in the Regatta, each boat competing shall be helmed by a female from the warning signal for her class until she has finished.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats with valid 2012 PHRF-GB certificates (spinnaker and non-spinnaker), boats entering for GBCA Club Handicap, and others that can form a one design class and supply a set of class rules, subject to the discretion of the race committee. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 hours Wednesday, September 12, 2012 will be awarded trophies as follows:

• 3 boats: 1 place

4-5 boats: 1, 2 place

6-8 boats: 1, 2, 3 place
9-10 boats: 1, 2, 3, 4 place

11 or more boats: 1 through 5 place

Classes which form after 1700 hours Wednesday, September 12, 2012 are eligible for trophies but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony.

PHRF certificates may be uploaded at the time of registration (preferred), or delivered to the competitors briefing. The entry fee will be \$40.00. Current members of US Sailing will receive a \$5.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the entry deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, September 14, 2012 at 1930 CST; however, entries received after 2359 CST, Wednesday, September 12, 2012 will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

Boats intending to race in a handicap fleet other than GBCA Club Handicap must have delivered a current PHRF-GB rating certificate to the Race Committee or uploaded it to Regatta Network before the conclusion of the competitors briefing.

Courses

Courses will be windward-leeward of various lengths, fixed marks or a combination of both; located in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and San Leon.

Sailing Instructions

Any change to the sailing instructions or to the schedule of races will be posted before 0800 on the day it will take effect.

Scoring

One completed race constitutes a series. No races will be excluded from scoring. This Modifies RRS A4.

Schedule of Events

A Competitors Briefing's will be held at the GBCA office at 1900 Friday, September 14th.

As many races as practical will be run during the regatta. Subsequent races for each class will be started as soon as possible after the class has finished the prior race. The warning signal for the first race of the regatta will not be before 1100 hours September 15th.

Trophy presentation and party will be held on Saturday, September 15th after the conclusion of the last race at the GBCA office.
