1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the VX ONE Class rules (www.vxone.org).
- 1.2. The Racing Rules may be altered by the regatta sailing instructions.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) will apply except the prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4. A complete list of US Sailing Prescriptions is available on the US Sailing website.
- 1.4. Part B of the Class rules may be modified for this event.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all members of the VX One Class Association. All boats and sails may be inspected for compliance with the Class Rules (www.vxone.org).

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry registration and fee of \$150.00 shall be completed by October 31, 2012. Registrations after October 31, 2012 will be \$170 and will be accepted until 1200 on November 8, 2012. Registration and other information can be found at www.vxonenac.com.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. 10 races will be attempted for the Championship, and three completed races will constitute a series.

4.2. Daily Schedule:

Thursday, November 8, 2012

0900 - 1200 Registration and measurement
1300 - Tune-up clinic on land
1400 - Tune-up clinic on water/Practice race
1800 - Skippers' Meeting - Grill Room

Friday, November 9, 2012

0830 - 0930 Registration
1055 - Warning Signal for first race of the day; additional races will follow.
Class meeting/roundtable following racing.

Saturday, November 10, 2012

1055 - Warning Signal for first race of the day; additional races will follow.

Sunday, November 11, 2012

0925 - Warning Signal for first race of the day; additional races may follow.
1400 - No race will start after this time.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND VENUE

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk.
- 5.2. The VX ONE North American Championship will be sailed in conjunction with the Jubilee Regatta on a separate course.
- 5.3. Races will be sailed on Pensacola Bay.

6. SCORING

- 6.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
When fewer than 6 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her races scores with none excluded. This changes RRS A2.
When 6 or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Trophies will be awarded for the first five places. Other awards may be given.
