NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* updated January 2010, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

- 1.2 Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows:
The use of powered winches is authorized.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will not be restricted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all Class boats and racer/cruisers with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs. Eligible boats may be entered at <http://www.waikikiyachtclub.com/RE/2012-Regatta-Information.aspx>

4 CLASSES

Yachts will be scored in class if there are 3 or more entries. HPHRF ratings will apply to all other entries and for overall scoring.

Entry deadline: 1800 Wednesday November 7th 2012

Skippers' Meeting: 1000 Sunday November 11th 2012

First Warning: 1255 Sunday November 11th 2012

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7 VENUE

The Course Area will be off the south shore of Oahu.

8 COURSES

Course 1: Start – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Finish.

Course 2: Start – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Finish.

Cruiser Course: Start Mark 1 to Starboard –DH to Port - HH to Starboard – Finish at G1

Maps will be provided with the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

Boats competing in the Beer Can Bash cruising class may be eligible for ratings “adjustments” . Skippers must submit their request and rationale to scottbradley@hawaii.rr.com prior to the skippers meeting. Adjustments will be announced at the meeting. If requested, 3 second adjustments will be given out for “white sails” . Rumor has it that there will be a request from Hana Hou for a ratings adjustment for having the oldest combined crew or most artificial hips (they can’t remember which one). Other potential “adjustments” that would receive series consideration: willingness to ring the bell at the bar, offers to buy a round for the race committee, oldest bottom job, best dressed crew, best crew costume etc.,.
