

# 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing updated January 2010,* the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**1.2** Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows: The use of powered winches is authorized.

## 2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will not be restricted.

## **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

## 4 CLASSES

Yachts will be scored in class if there are 3 or more entries. HPHRF ratings will apply to all other entries and for overall scoring.

### 8 COURSES

Course 1: Start – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Finish. Course 2: Start – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Mark 1 to Port – Mark 2 to Port – Finish. Cruiser Course: Start Mark 1 to Starboard –DH to Port - HH to Starboard – Finish at G1 Maps will be provided with the sailing instructions.

### 9 SCORING

Boats competing in the Beer Can Bash cruising class may be eligible for ratings "adjustments". Skippers must submit their request and rational to <u>scottbradley@hawaii.rr.com</u> prior to the skippers meeting. Adjustments will be announced at the meeting. If requested, 3 second adjustments will be given out for "white sails". Rumor has it that there will be a request from Hana Hou for a ratings adjustment for having the oldest combined crew or most artificial hips (they can't remember which one). Other potential "adjustments" that would receive series consideration: willingness to ring the bell at the bar, offers to buy a round for the race committee, oldest bottom job, best dressed crew, best crew costume etc,.
