- 1. The rules will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 2012 as proscribed by ISAF, Class Rules, and the Sailing Instructions for the regatta and the amendments thereto.
- 2. Eligibility: For Optimists, the regatta is open to those sailors age 15 and younger, provided they do not turn 16 in 2013. For lasers and 420s the regatta is open to sailors of any age, male or female.
- 3. Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be distributed by 9:30 A.M., January 21th.
- 4. Classes: There will be a Green fleet class, as well as the Red (ages 15, 14, and 13), White (age ten and under) and Blue (ages 12 and 11) fleets, as defined by the USODA. The 420 class **will** use spinnakers and traps. The Laser Radials, 4.7 and Full Rigs will start together and sail the same course.
- 5. Races: The regatta will be designed for five races on Saturday, and five races on Sunday. The race committee may at its own discretion fit in more races if it deems it to be appropriate.
- 6. Scoring: Scoring will be done by the low point scoring system, with one throw out if more than 5 races are completed.
- 7. Prizes: There will be prizes for the first three places in each class. There will be a prize for first overall in the Optimist class. Other prizes may be awarded.
