1. **Organizing Authority**

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

2. **Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the ISCA Class Rules.

3. **Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all US Sunfish Class and International Sunfish Class Members.

4. **Registration & Fees**

**4.1** Registration is \$75 per boat. All registrations received after March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2013 will be charged a \$10 late fee. Registration fee includes 2 dinners, regatta apparel, entertainment, complimentary beer and water. Pizza after the race Sunday will be served. Lunches may be purchased each day by ordering onsite the day before needed.
