NOTICE OF RACE Amendment One

Del Rey Yacht Club, Marina del Rey and Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club

Del Rey Yacht Club cordially invites **ORR**, **PHRF**, **ORCA** and **Cruising** - **Novice** class boats to race in this new race to Inaugural Newport Beach the week before the Lexis Newport to Ensenada race.

Rules: This race shall be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

The SoCal PHRF Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule will not apply to this race. However, individuals who meet the definition of a MIR under the SoCal PHRF Class Rules will not be allowed to steer a Cruising Class - Novice boat.

Eligibility: This event is open to ORR, PHRF, OD, ORCA, and Cruising - Novice class boats with a valid 2013 SoCal PHRF rating certificate.

Entries: Only online entries will be accepted (see <u>www.dryc.org</u> for details), no later than 1800 on Friday, April 19.

The entry fee is \$35 (\$30 for members of US Sailing). No entries will be accepted on Saturday, the day of the race. Payment maybe made online or delivered to the DRYC front desk or the Race Committee no later 0830, April 21, 2013

For Cruising - Novice Class boats, the DRYC Cruising Class Handicap System shall be used (based on a valid PHRF certificate with adjustments to be determined by the DRYC Cruising Class Chairman). To be eligible to race in the DRYC Cruising Class entrants are required to be PHRF members with a valid certificate and submit a completed DRYC cruising class handicap form prior to April 18.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be available online on the DRYC and BCYC websites and at the DRYC front desk at least two days prior to the race. The official notice board will be the bulletin board on the hallway inside the main entrance to the DRYC Club House.

Classes: Class splits will be determined based upon the number of entries received by 1600 on the Thursday before the race. That information plus the Order of Starts will be posted no later than 0900 on the morning of the race.

Starting Time and Location: The Warning Signal for the first class to start is 1055. The starting line will be set in the vicinity of the "H" Mark, approximately 1/2 nm at a heading of 235° from the middle of the Marina del Rey detached breakwater.

Course: The race will start off Marina del Rey and finish off Balboa Pier at Newport Beach, CA. The course distance is 40 nautical miles.

Handicaps: For PHRF classes, OW base Ratings will be used. Cruising - Novice handicap ratings are based on the DRYC Cruiser Handicap with additional adjustments administered by DRYC.

Time Limit: The time limit is 2300. All boats not finishing before the Time Limit will be scored Did Not Finish. This changes RRS 35.

Trophies: Three trophies in each class will be awarded at BCYC at 1000 on Sunday, April 21.

Slip Reservations: Limited docking will be available at DRYC. Reservations are required in advance and should be made by calling the DRYC Office at 310-823-4664. Docking information in Newport Harbor is available by calling by calling BCYC at 949-644-9530.
