Rendezvous: Competitors shall check in with the "Race Committee Check-In" boat flying a large *yellow* flag prior to their warning signal. The "Race Committee Check-In" boat will be stationed approximately 300 yards NW of the Race Committee Signal Boat. The signal boat will fly a *blue* Race Committee flag.
Please do not attempt to check in with the Race Committee Signal Boat.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee at both ends. Competitors retiring from the race are requested to notify the Race Committee by hail or VHF.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee signal boat and Annapolis Area Mark "X", or alternative mark if the Race Committee displays the "L" flag and moves to another location.

Course: **COURSE 1:** Annapolis Area Chart, round Bloody Point Light, and Marks "L" (G "1") and "F" (R "2A") to port, and Mark "N" (R "4") to starboard (17.5 nautical miles).

COURSE 2: Annapolis Area Chart, round Marks "Q" (R "84A") and "F" (R "2A") to port, and Mark "N" (R "4") to starboard (20.9 nautical miles).

Finish: Region 3 Miles River and Eastern Bay Area Mark "E" (C "9") and split as follows:
HANDICAP CLASSES: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Buoy C "9".
ONE DESIGN CLASSES: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and the orange drop mark.

Shortened Course Finish:

HANDICAP CLASSES: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and the shortened-course mark.

ONE DESIGN CLASSES: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and an orange drop mark.

This changes Rule 32.2.

Time Limit: 8 hours from start of Class.

Protest: A boat intending to protest shall inform the Race Committee as soon as possible after finishing by hail until acknowledged. The hail shall include the sail number or boat name of the protested yacht. The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the arrival of the Race Committee signal boat at the dock. Written protests must be filed at MRYC Race Committee desk located in the Commodore's Room. Protests will be heard on Saturday 25 May 2013 at the MRYC Pool House second floor as posted on the official race bulletin board.

Awards: 1st/5, 2nd/7, 3rd/9 & 4th/15 in each class.
Rhine Trophy will be awarded to the MRYC skipper with the best corrected finish time per mile.
Awards will be presented at approximately 2000 at the post-race party.

Social: Skippers and their guests are invited to rendezvous at MRYC after the race.
Live entertainment, food and drink will be featured on Saturday after the race.

Other: Additional information, including scratch sheets, shall be posted on the MRYC Website www.milesriveryc.org when available.

Docking: Slips are available on a first come first served basis at \$40 per slip plus electricity if used. Contact MRYC on VHF channel 68 as you approach Long Haul Creek.

Rafting: The rafting off the pier T-heads is free. There is also free rafting in the Club's West basin for boats drawing four feet or less. Please follow rafting instructions from the club patrol boat.

Tender Service: For boats wishing to anchor in or near Long Haul Creek, tender service will be available on Saturday from race finish to midnight.
On Sunday, tender service will begin at 0645 and end at 1000.

Food/Drink: A la carte food options will be available on the lawn or inside the Club starting after the racing concludes. Beer and apparel stations will also be available. Tables for dining will be available on the lawn and inside the Club. Ice will be available for racers from arrival to departure. Breakfast will be served Sunday starting at 0700 for \$9. Please remember that alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto, or taken from the MRYC grounds (liquor license issues).

Club Access: MRYC is committed to make visiting sailors feel safe and welcome at our Club. All Club facilities will be available to visiting sailors. The pool will be open, so bring your bathing suit. Children 14 and under must be supervised by an adult when in the pool area.

Showers/Rest Rooms: All showers and restrooms in the Club and Pool house will be open all weekend. However, because our septic system has limited capacity, we ask our visitors to help us and use the portable facilities on the grounds to the extent possible.

No Camping: Please note that overnight camping (e.g. tents, campers, trailers, RVs) on the MRYC grounds is illegal due to Talbot County zoning restrictions. Sleeping on your boat is always welcome.

Parking: Racers and guests may park in the Club field on Friday and Saturday. Please do not block the boat wash-down areas.

NEW THIS YEAR – Bus Transportation Back to Annapolis: Buses will depart from Miles River Yacht Club at 1900 and 2115 on Saturday May 25 for those participants who want to return to Annapolis. The cost will be \$25 per person. Additional details will be posted on www.milesriveryc.org at least one week prior to the race.
