1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 Eligible boats and drivers may enter by completing an online entry form available through the Regatta Network, a link and more information is available at www.asmbyc.org. Instructions will also be provided at the seminar, or contact the race committee at race@sbyrc.org.
- 2.2 An eligible driver is one that has not helmed a boat in more than one ORCA, One Design, PHRF or two cruising races within the last 12 months.
- 2.3 Completed entry forms will be accepted until 0900 hours Sunday, April 21, 2013.
- 2.4 Boats and or drivers do not need to be members of PHRF nor any other organization.
- 2.5 The entry fee is FREE for all boats.

3. PRE RACE SEMINAR:

A seminar will be held at Pacific Mariners Yacht Club on April 16th beginning at 1830 hours (6:30 p.m.). Attendance is highly recommended for skippers of boats with no racing experience. Please bring your crew. All other skippers are encouraged to attend.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS / SKIPPERS MEETING:

The sailing instructions will be available at the seminar and at the skipper's meeting, which will be held on Sunday, April 21st, at 0900 hours at PMYC before the race.

5. MENTORS:

Experienced racers are available to act as mentors for the race. Contact Greg Rutter at sbyrcpublicity@gmail.com.

6. SCHEDULE OF RACE:

- 6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1255 hours.
- 6.2 The R/C will attempt to run up to 3 races in such a way as to finish racing by 1700 hours (5 p.m.).

7. THE COURSES / SCORING:

- 7.1 Courses will be windward, leeward and random leg using marks from MdR course chart 16.
- 7.2 No race score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

8. HOSPITALITY:

Snacks will be available at the skipper's meeting, and at the awards ceremony, which will also include a no-host bar. Once all the competitors have finished racing, the party will begin at PMYC at 13915 Panay Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

9. PRIZES:

- 9.1 The first place winner of each class will have their name engraved on the Darien Murray Memorial Trophy.
- 9.2 Individual "Take Home" trophies will also be presented.
