FOURTH RACE OF THE KHYC 2013 SPINNAKER SERIES

First Race of the Quantum Around the Point Series

SATURDAY, June 15, 2013

RULES: This race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. This race is a Category 4 event.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. PHRF entrants must hold a current PHRF certificate. Multihulls, Martin 242s, Vipers and other one design classes are invited, as well as sport boats, cruisers and double handed boats. Double handed boats will race in their respective classes. At least three entries will constitute a class. Advance registration by mail must be received at KHYC by June 12th. Registration is also available at regattanetwork.com. There is a \$20 entry fee.

VENUE: This is a point to point race **starting** at KHYC "S" Mark (Santa Monica Bay) and **finishing** at CB Mark "82" (Los Angeles Harbor). Refer to the current KHYC Race Mark Guide and Event Race Chart, as well as, the Sailing Instructions available at regattanetwork.com and at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

DIVISIONS: Class splits for the entire series have been determined using PHRF area buoy ratings; 'A' 137 or less, 'B' 138 or higher. This does not alter the rating protocol used to score this event. Double handed boats and boats without lifelines must wear USCG approved pfd's at all times during the race.

STARTS: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning for "B" boats will be at 1155. "B" boats will start at 1200. "A" boats' warning will be at 1225, start at 1230. (Note: Other classes will start in the interval between the "B" start at 1200 and the "A" start at 1230). Boats must sail by the RC boat prior to the 1st warning signal for their class in order to be recognized as a starter.

FINISH: The finish will be between a committee boat and the mark CB "82" inside LA Harbor.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Regional OWC Course ratings will apply with Time-On-Time scoring for this race. Area ratings do not apply for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at CBYC following the race. The H.A Simms Perpetual trophy for PHRF A & B will be presented at the KHYC annual awards event.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome at the KHYC Clubhouse before the race. KHYC's galley will be open on the Friday before the race for lunch between 11:30am and 2:00pm and hearty appetizers will be served at the bar from 6:00 to 9:00pm. Saturday morning the galley is open for breakfast beginning at 8:30am. Dinner will be available at CBYC on Saturday night. Please contact Dianna Price at CBYC regarding the Saturday night dinner.

DOCKING and SLIPS: Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities; the guest dock is available on a first-come, first serve basis. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the guest dock. Additional slips may be obtained from King Harbor Marina at a discounted overnight rate for registered race participants at (310) 376-6926. Slips at CBYC are available on Saturday for a short-term stay as well as overnight. If you need a berthing following the race, please contact Diana Price in advance with your boat length and draft as well as your intention to stay overnight.
