NOTICE OF RACE

THE WINDWARD LEEWARD RACE (Spinnaker #6)

SIXTH RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES

SATURDAY, September 28, 2013

An ASMBYC High Point Event

RULES: This race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. PHRF entrants must hold a current PHRF certificate. Multihulls, Martin 242s, Vipers and other one design classes are invited, at least three entries will constitute a class. Advance registration by mail must be received at KHYC by September 27th. Registration is also available at regattanetwork.com. There will be a \$20 single race entry fee.

VENUE: The race area will be per the current KHYC Race Mark Guide, the Sailing Instructions and the Course Chart available at regattanetwork.com or at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

DIVISIONS: PHRF class splits, using PHRF Area-B Buoy ratings, are as follows: A (137 or less) - B (138 or higher). This is a PHRF Category 4 event and PHRF Area B2 Buoy ratings will apply for scoring.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: Three races are scheduled per the course chart for this event. One race will constitute the regatta. There will be no throw-outs.

STARTS: In the vicinity of "K" mark. The first warning will be at 1155. Subsequent class starts are at 5 minute intervals.

FINISH: The finish line will be the same as the start line.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Area B2 Buoy Course ratings will apply with TOT scoring for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The Mayor's Perpetual trophy will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards event (PHRF A&B).

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. The bar opens at 1500 and post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
