



The Bridgeton Harbor NYRA Invitational Regatta 2013 March 23th and 24th NOTICE OF RACE

Come join us at Bridgeton Harbor for the 2013 NYRA Invitational Regatta. Bridgeton Harbor is standing behind its strategy to be a long-term partner with local sailors to promote racing and sailing on the upper Neuse River.

Bridgeton Harbor Marina will host the event at their new marina facility in Bridgeton, a few blocks upriver from the bridge. **FREE deep water slips (11 feet) will be offered free of charge, compliments of Bridgeton Harbor Marina, for all racing sailboats, on a space available basis**. One-design classes (SJ21, Sunfish, Laser, Ensign, etc.) will race near the Bridgeton Harbor Marina on the Neuse. Multiple races are planned for each day.

Anticipated **PHRF** handicapped classes are Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker, and Cruising. An appropriate course down the Neuse River and back will be set for the anticipated weather conditions. One race is planned for each day

The Cruising class is offered to encourage normally non-racing boats and sailors to participate. Boats without a current rating certificate will be assigned a handicap by the race committee and may race in any class. Boats in the cruising class will race *free of charge* if the owner joins NYRA, or is a current NYRA member. (The PRO reserves the right to assign yachts to either NON-SPINNAKER or CRUISING class depending on his/her sole determination of the cruising character of the yacht.) No trophy hunting here-let's just encourage more boats to get out on the river racing!

The scoring system will be Time on Time for PHRF boats. One completed race will constitute a regatta. Awards will be given in One Design, Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker, and Cruising classes as deemed appropriate by the PRO. Awards will be based on the number of entries in each class. Two registered boats constitute a class.

The CRUISING class and Junior Sunfish sailors will race FREE OF CHARGE if they are NYRA members (Membership application is available at www.nyra.org, and will be available at the skipper's meeting).
