NOTICE OF RACE

The 2013 Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association Silver Pacific Coast Championship will be organized by the Sausalito Yacht Club, in association with the PCISA and Bay Area Youth Sailing.

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA Supplemental Rules), the 2013-16 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Teams must be a current member of ISSA. Schools may register as many full teams as desired.
- 2.2 A team is comprised of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 sailors who must attend the same high school in grades 9-12.
- 2.3 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach or parent and must be recognized by the school.
- 2.4 PCISA Rule 8.5 will be in effect as follows: The Silver Championship Regatta will not allow a sailor who has been a skipper in more than one 10% regatta in the gold fleet during the current PCISA season to participate as a skipper or crew.

3. BOATS

- 3.1 Each team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ in excellent condition. Secure hull and tank plugs are mandatory, and teams should have spare plugs.
- 3.2 All boats will be inspected Saturday morning at the SYC dock prior to racing in the event. Each boat is required to use sails issued by the PCISA.

4. CHARTERS

Charter boats will not be provided by the regatta organizers. Teams desiring charters must make arrangements directly with potential providers from local yacht clubs.

5. ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 \$120 per team includes the PCISA sail fee, awards, continental breakfast each day, and food at the Club on Saturday after racing.
- 5.2 No lunch will be provided, but there are many good restaurants within a short walk of the venue.

7. ENTRY & REGISTRATION

7.1 **The online entry form must be completed by 5pm on Friday, April 5, 2013.** At the discretion of the organizer, entries may not be accepted after this date. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry. For a link to online entry go to: <http://pcisa.hssailing.org/schedule/2012-2013>

7.2 There will be an on-site registration desk at the regatta, where teams must check in, collect SIs, and pick up any other regatta information.

8. BOAT LAUNCHING AND STORAGE

8.1 Boats must be launched at the public launch ramp next to 1200 Bridgeway, Sausalito.

8.2 Trailer storage will be available in a lot adjacent to SYC. Overnight boat storage will be on the SYC docks and "G Docks" very close to SYC. Dollies must be brought to those locations for overnight boat storage. Docking location will be assigned by lottery at registration.

9. COMPETITORS MEETINGS AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

Competitors meetings will be held at 1000 Saturday and 0930 on Sunday. SIs will be available at registration.

10. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be off of the Sausalito waterfront, with rotations made from the Trident Restaurant floating dock if the course is set closest to this dock, otherwise rotations will be made from the SYC dock. Coaches & spectators can view the racing from the shore south of the Trident Restaurant, although no tents will be allowed in this public area. If the racecourse is closer to SYC coaches and spectators may set up on the SYC deck.

11. COACHING

All coaching, crew rotation, exchange of clothing/food/drink and communication shall only occur on docks at either Horizon's Restaurant or SYC. Coaches are not allowed on the water. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee.

12. DECISIONS OF THE JURY

Decisions of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS Rule 70.5.

13. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, with the exception that each school cannot be awarded more than one of these trophies.

14. NEARBY HOTELS

Hotels in downtown Sausalito are all fairly fancy and expensive. Other close options in order of distance are:

- Tam Woods Hotel (\$\$)
- America's Best Value Inn (\$)
- Acqua Hotel (\$\$\$)

There are also a number of chain hotels in Corte Madera and Larkspur, which are all less than 15 minutes away.
