## 11. THE START

11.3. The starting line on **Sunday** will be located **offshore near the power plant**, with the line located between an orange inflatable buoy and the staff of an orange flag on the Main Race Committee Boat.

## 12. THE FINISH

12.1. The finish line on **Saturday** will be located **offshore near the power plant**, with the line located between an orange inflatable buoy and the staff of an orange flag on the Main Race Committee Boat. Yachts shall check in with Race Committee on VHF 68

or by calling the principal race officer Marty Loo at 838-9629 after passing Barbers Point on their final approach to the finish.

- 12.2. The finish line on **Sunday** will extend 100' seaward from **R2** and a point in the HYC club house with approximate bearing of 017° magnetic. Yachts shall check in with Race Committee on VHF 68 or by calling the principal race officer Marty Loo at 838-9629 after passing Honolulu Harbor on their final approach to the finish.
- 12.3. Boats finishing after 1700 hours shall record their own finish time and report it to the Race Committee as soon as possible.

### **13. TIME LIMITS**

The time limit for each class is 1800 hours.
