North Carolina Offshore Championship Regatta

May 24, 25 and 26, 2013

The NCOC Regatta is the premier offshore regatta on the North Carolina Coast. The NC Maritime Museum will host the shore based activities at their Gallants Channel facility near Beaufort. Access via water is next to Town Creek Marina and access via land is on West Beaufort Road, gate 3, just beyond Town Creek Marina.

The Regatta will be governed by the 20013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing. All boats shall comply with N.C. Wildlife Commission and U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations. Three or more races are planned for all Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker classes, but one completed race will constitute the regatta. A fun Cruising class race is also planned for Saturday only. The Cruising class will be limited to boats that do not traditionally participate in offshore racing. Placement in this class is subject to reassignment into another class at the sole discretion of the PRO. Sailing Instructions will be available on www.nyra.org and at registration. The race courses will be set approximately 2 miles east of Beaufort Entrance channel marker 10.

Eligibility. The Regatta is open to mono-hulled sailboats 21 feet or more overall with a current NC-PHRF rating. Eligible boats may enter online at our website athttp://www.nyra.org/new/, or by completing an entry form and sending it together with the required fee to NYRA, PO Box 235, New Bern NC 28563 by May 20, 2013. Late entries will be accepted at late registration until 8:00 pm Friday May 27.

Classes. A minimum of three boats will constitute a class. Classes are planned for spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and cruising fleets. Each fleet may be broken into multiple classes based on PHRF rating, depending on the number of entries. The Cruising fleet's racing will be limited to Saturday only.
