**NOTICE OF RACE**

### **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY HUDSON YACHT CLUB**

#### **1. RULES**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as they may be amended by this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

#### **2. ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to eligible sailors in the following classes:

**Opti green** born 1998-2005 (age 8-15), first year racing.

**Opti red** born 1998-2000 (age 13-15)

**Opti blue** born 2001-2002 (age 11-12)

**Opti white** born (2003-2005)

**Laser 4.7** 12-16 yrs old

**Laser radial** 12 and up

**Laser** 16 and up

**29er** 15 and up

**Club 420** 12 and up

**2.4m** open

**Boarding** 15 and up

**Open class** open

All ages are as at December 31, 2013

- 3.2. Eligible sailors may enter by registering online-hyperlink to registration will be available at [www.HudsonYachtClub.com](http://www.HudsonYachtClub.com)
- 3.3. All competitors must present proof of age.
- 3.4. All competitors must present any required waivers and medical release forms signed by a parent or legal guardian at the sailor check-in desk. Required waivers and medical release forms are available to download during on-line registration.

- 3.5. For competitors who have not reached the age of consent, the parent or guardian of such competitor shall identify in writing a parent or adult representative that shall be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.

**4. FEES**

- 4.1. Required fees are as follows:

Payments are due upon registration. The on-line pre-registration entry fee of \$ 130.00 per person includes: 2 days of clinics, lunch on all four 4 days, dinner on Saturday (extra dinner tickets are available).

The on-site entry fee is \$ 150.00. Coach fees are \$ 70.00 on-line and \$ 90.00 on-site. In addition to above, the coach fee includes a Coach dinner party and gas for coach boat.

- 4.2. Weekend races only fees are as follows: \$65.00 for on-line pre-registration; \$75.00 on-site registration. Coaches: \$35.00 for pre-registration and \$45.00 for on-site registration.

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon completion of registration at the Hudson Yacht Club.

## **7. VENUE**

- 7.1. The Hudson Yacht Club is located in the town of Hudson on the Lake of Two Mountains.
- 7.2. Regatta participants and registered campers may use the club facilities during the Regatta.
- 7.3. HYC by-laws do not allow dogs on club grounds except for going and returning to boats in the harbour.

## **8. THE COURSES**

There will be three course areas. Courses will be Windward/Leeward or Trapezoid and will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## **9. PENALTY SYSTEM**

For the 29er class Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **10. SCORING**

Seven races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to constitute a series.

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, or after the regatta.

## **12. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13. PRIZES**

- 13.1. Keeper prizes will be awarded for first through third places in every qualifying fleet, minimum six boats per fleet, except the Opti Green Fleet.

- 13.2. Opti Green Fleet will receive participation prizes.
- 13.3. There will be a sportsmanship award in each class.

#### **14. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

#### **15. SAFETY**

All boats are required to have a minimum 5 metre long by 7mm diameter floating line attached to the mast while afloat. Sheets or other rigging may not be substituted for this purpose.

#### **16. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

In participating in the event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
