NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section B (POST RACE PENALTIES) will apply.
- 1.3 All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes rule 40.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

Melges 24, Etchells, Express 27

- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at www.sfyc.org.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$100 (\$95 for members of US SAILING), if received by April 16th. A \$20 late fee will be charged after April 16th.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

- 3.1 The first warning signal will be at 11:30 Hours on both Saturday and Sunday. Three (3) races are scheduled on Saturday and two (2) races are scheduled on Sunday.
- 3.2 On each day, subsequent races will be started as soon as possible following the previous race.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after April 16, 2013, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions. All marks will be inflatable buoys.

6. COMMUNICATIONS:

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 7.1 For the Melges 24 Class rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty.
- 7.2 For the Express 27 Class, Appendix T Section A (Penalties While Racing) will apply.

8. SCORING:

Two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.

11. DOCKAGE:
