1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in current The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules of the International Sunfish Class (except as altered by the sailing instructions), and the sailing instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry
