NOTICE OF RACE

2012 Spring Dinghy Regatta

April 27 – 28, 2013

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while on the water.
- 1.3. Rule 44.1 will be changed; the Two-Turns Penalty will be replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. Changes to rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to the 505 Class; any dinghy class with more than three boats wishing to enter may petition the Organizing Authority. All dinghy classes are warmly welcomed.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Early entry fee is \$80 for double-handed boats and \$60 for single-handed boats if received prior to 1800 hours April 25, 2013.
- 3.2. Youth skippers under 18 deduct \$20 from the entry fee if received prior to 1800 hours April 25, 2012.
- 3.3. Late entry fee is \$100 for double-handed boats and \$80 for single-handed boats if received after 1800 hours April 25, 2013.
- 3.4. Entry fees include taco bar dinner and social event at the SCYC Clubhouse on Saturday night.
- 3.5. Additional dinners can be purchased for \$18 for Adults and \$6 for children younger than 12.
- 3.6. All entry fees are nonrefundable.
- 3.7. There will be a nominal trailer and vehicle parking charge at Santa Cruz Harbor.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. There will be a Competitors' Briefing on April 27th at 1100 hours and an awards presentation on April 28th after racing in the SCYC Clubhouse
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal both days is 1255 hours.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on-line, at the Competitors' Briefing and will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. Venue

- 6.1. Racing will be around inflatable buoys in an area approximately 2.5 miles Santa Cruz Harbor.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2. When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. The number of prizes to be awarded will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
