NOTICE OF RACE (**Note edited start time for Women's/Junior Nationals 8/2/2013**)

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 Edition (RRS), and the JET 14 Class Constitution

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Regulation 20

3. ELIGIBILITY

To skipper in either the Jet-14 Women's or Jet-14 Nationals, one must be either a 2013 Active member (boat owners and co-owners only) or a 2013 Associate or Junior member (co-owners and non-owners) who is skippering a boat that is owned by a 2013 Active member and registered with the Jet-14 Class. For the Junior Nationals, the skipper must be a 2013 Junior member, and skipper and crew shall not reach their 20th birthday before January 1, 2014. All Active, Associate, and Junior members must be in good standing with the Jet 14 Class to qualify. Co-helming is allowed provided both skippers meet the above requirements.

4. REGISTRATION FEES

You may register in person at LNYC, by regular mail to the address below, or Online. REGISTRATION BY MAIL OR ONLINE IS ENCOURAGED FOR PLANNING PURPOSES. Mail registration should be prepared using the appropriate form and fee, and postmarked NO LATER THAN **August 1** 2013. Please note, to order lunches and receive T-shirts, registration must be postmarked by Friday, **July 21**, or received online by **July 24**. The registration must be received by the Organizing Authority by the deadlines specified. Registration forms will be mailed to paid Jet-14 class members, and will be available at LNYC when the registration desk is open.

Women's/Junior National Championships – No entry fee, no food included. Registration closes at 9:30 am Wednesday August 7, 2012. Online registration is not available for this event.

National Championship: Registration: \$185 per boat (includes for skipper and crew: daily continental breakfast, after race refreshments, Thursday Dinner, Friday dinner, Saturday lunch, and T-shirts*). Make checks payable to: "Jet 14 Class Association".

*Pre-Registration receives a \$10 discount and must be postmarked by July 21 2013 or online by July 25 to order daily lunches (\$6 each) and to receive T-shirts. Online registration closes Aug. 6. Registration at LNYC (desk) closes at **6:00 pm** Wednesday, August 7, 2013.

6. MEASUREMENT

Each yacht shall comply with the Jet 14 Class specifications. A completed measurement form (mailed with each registration packet, available online or in person at on-site registration) shall be submitted for each yacht. See measurement form for details.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 12:00 noon on Tuesday, August 6, 2013 at LNYC Registration Desk.

8. THE COURSES:

Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions

9. SCORING

- a. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will be used.
- b. A total of up to 10 races are planned for the National Championship. 3 races must be sailed and completed to award the National Championship. After 6 races are completed, one throw-out will be included, except scores not excludable in the RRS.
- c. The Women's and Junior National Championships will be up to 5 races with no throw-outs. One completed race will qualify for the awarding of the Women's/Junior National Championship

10. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with orange flags and remain well clear of the race course while boats are *racing*. a competitor may be disqualified in the event that boat's support boat enters the race area.

11. BOAT STORAGE AND HANDLING

Boats may be stored and launched from designated areas at LNYC beginning August 3. Boat launching is by ramps and is suggested, two ramps are available. If required, hoist launching is available.

12. PRIZES:

National Championship (trophies for skipper/crew):

Chevron Fleet: 1-10th place

President's Fleet: 1-5th place

Women's National Championship (trophies for skipper/crew):

1-3rd place

Junior National Championship (trophies for skipper/crew):

1-3rd place

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

At registration each competitor will be required to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property incurred in connection with this event or on the property of LNYC and to release LNYC, the Jet 14 Class, any sponsors of the event, and their members, officers, governors, employees, agents and sponsors from any liability for any such loss, damage, or injury. All competitors under the age of 18 shall have parental permission.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance sufficient to cover liability for loss, damage or personal injury or death.
