

**NOTICE OF RACE
CAROLINA YACHT CLUB
2013 OPEN REGATTA – July 27-28, 2013**



1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the 2012 SAYRA Junior Championship Series Notice of Race.

2. Racing rules will be changed as followed:

- 2.1 All races will be scored. This changes Appendix A2.
- 2.2 The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 2.3 E-Scows will be required to race with Float Paks at the top of the mast.
- 2.4 US Sailing Appendix T1, T2, T3, T4.2 and T 4.4 are in effect.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all one-design boats with 4 or more boats registered.
- 3.2 This is a Points Regatta for the SAYRA Junior Series for the Optimist, Sunfish, Laser and Club 420 classes.
- 3.3 Laser class boats may register and sail as Laser Full, Radial or 4.7. A boat must sail the regatta in the rig as registered.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form, which is attached and will be available at registration.

4. FEES:

5. SCHEDULE:

Friday, July 26th	1700-1830 Registration, Under the Boathouse
Saturday, July 27th	0900-1030 Registration, Under the Boathouse 1100 Skipper's Meeting, Boathouse 1225 First Warning, other race(s) to follow.
Sunday, July 28th	1200 First Warning, other race(s) to follow Awards Ceremony following the Protest Time Limit

6. SOCIAL:

- a. Continental breakfast under the Boathouse on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- b. Post race party following last race on Saturday.
- c. Boathouse and club restaurant are open to sailing participants and guests for the weekend (cash accepted).
Appropriate attire required for the Club restaurant.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

8. VENUE: Racing will be in beautiful Charleston harbor.

9. THE COURSES & CLASS FLAGS: The courses will be “around the buoys” and will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Class flags will be posted by 1100 Saturday.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM: US Sailing Appendix T1 is in effect except for the E-Scow and SIOD classes where Appendix T1 is modified so that only one turn is required when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 in the zone.

11. SCORING:

11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except that a boat’s final score shall be the sum of all races, with no throw outs. This changes Rule A2.

11.2 Five races are scheduled for Course A and B; an unlimited number of races scheduled for the Juniors course. One race will constitute a regatta.

12. AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded to first through fifth depending on size of fleet.
