Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Racing rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. The regatta will be held under the Wylie Wabbit Fleet Rules and Constitution available here: <http://wyliewabbit.org/articles/rules>

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all class legal Wylie Wabbits.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may only enter on-line at SCYC.org before **1000 hours, August 17, 2013**.

3. Fees

- 3.1. The regular entry fee is \$60. For all entries received after **1200 hours on August 15** a late entry penalty of \$40 will apply, making the total for late entry \$100.
- 3.2. Entry includes berthing in Santa Cruz Harbor on Friday and Saturday evenings.
- 3.3. Entry does NOT include parking at Santa Cruz Harbor for cars and trailers, a modest fee will be charged by the Harbor.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Saturday, August 17, 2013
 - 4.1.1. There will be a competitors' briefing at the SCYC Clubhouse at 1030 hours.
 - 4.1.2. Three (3) races are scheduled.
 - 4.1.3. Wine tasting and Pot-Luck dinner at the SCYC Clubhouse after racing.
- 4.2. Sunday, August 18, 2013
 - 4.2.1. Two races are scheduled.
 - 4.2.2. Trophy Presentation as soon as practical after racing at SCYC.
- 4.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal each day is 1300 hours.
- 4.4. On Saturday, August 17th, the Wylie Wabbit division shall start after the SCYC One-Design Fleets.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available before 1100 on August 12, 2013 on-line and at the competitor's briefing.

6. Venue & Courses

- 6.1. The venue is the Monterey Bay within four (4) miles of Walton Lighthouse.
- 6.2. Courses shall be Windward/Leeward and Triangle around inflatable set marks.

7. Prizes

- 7.1. Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of regular entries.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

- 8.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 8.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
