

# 2013 JACK & JILL REGATTA

## SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 22, 2013

## 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Changes to the RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2 Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 2.1 Boats holding a valid 2013 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 2.2 There will be PHRF divisions as follows: spinnaker, non-spinnaker and families with children under the age of 16. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except for the family division. Final division assignments will be made at the competitors' meeting.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may register and pay online at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/7363</u> or scyc.org. Entries will be accepted before 1055 on September 22, 2013.

#### 3 Fees

- 3.1 The early fee is \$45. Boats may register early online by 2000 on September 21, 2013.
- 3.2 The regular entry fee is \$65. Boats may register online by 1055 September 22, 2013.

#### 4 Schedule

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting will be at 1100 hours on September 22, 2013 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3 One race is scheduled.
- 4.4 One race will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony and appetizers at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

#### **5** Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting. They may be posted earlier on the SCYC website.

## 6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

## 7 Courses

7.1 Courses will be distributed with the Sailing Instructions.

## 7 Scoring

7.1 No score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

## 8 Prizes

8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
