



Notice of Race Carlisle Classic November 16, 2013

1. **Rules**

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Clearwater Community Sailing Association (CCSA). The event will be held at the Clearwater Community Sailing Center (CCSC), 1001 Gulf Blvd., Clearwater, FL 33767.

Language - The official language for this Regatta will be English.

2. **Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 Entries are invited from any boats that have been assigned a Portsmouth Handicap, or who will sail in a one-design fleet with a minimum of three (3) entries. Some of the expected classes are Windmills, Optis, Lasers, Laser Radial, 420s, Techno 293 Windsurfers, Kona Windsurfers, Access Dinghies, Portsmouth. Windmills will be on a separate course.
- 2.2 The Organizing Authority reserves the right to cancel the Regatta if a reasonable number of entries are not received by October, 1st. In the event of cancellation—full refunds will be made.

- 3. **Risk**- It is the competitors decision to enter the Regatta and to start or continue any race (see (RRS 4). Each competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during or after the regatta.

4. **Scheduled Events**

- 4.1 Saturday November 16th
 - 0800-1030 Registration
 - 1000 Skippers Meeting
 - 1100 First Warning
 - Awards will follow last race.

4.2 No warning signal shall be made after 1400 on Saturday

4.3 A minimum of one race shall constitute a regatta.

- 5. **Registration** – Competitors may register by completing the regatta registration form and delivering it with the appropriate fees to: Clearwater Community Sailing Center (CCSC), 1001 Gulf Blvd. Clearwater, FL 33767. You can also register [online](#).

6. **Fees**

6.1 The entry fee is \$40 for single handed boats and \$60 for double handed boats. There is a \$10 late fee per boat for entries received after November 10th 2013

6.2 The entry fee includes racing, lunch on the water.

7. **Courses**

7.1 The race committee will select courses and group fleets based on conditions for competing courses.

7.2 The racing area will be in Clearwater Bay to the southeast of the Clearwater Community Sailing Center and the Gulf.

- 8. **Scoring** - The Low Point scoring system, RRS A2 will apply, except that if fewer than five (5) races are completed, all races shall be included in the total score.

- 9. **Sailing Instructions**- Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration
