SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current ***Racing Rules of Sailing***, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the prescriptions of HYRA, by the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

- 1.2** Racing rule 52 will be changed as follows:
The use of powered winches is authorized.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the WYC card room.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the WYC flagpole.

5. SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAGS

Skippers' Meeting: 1030 Saturday November 9th 2013
The warning signal for the first race will be at 12:25 Saturday November 9th 2013.
Races 2 & 3 will follow approx. 5 min after last finish in previous race.

The class flag is: PH Black with 1

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be ½ to 1 ½ mile off Ala Wai channel.

7. COURSES and MARKS

The courses will be:

Course 1 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port and finish.

Course 2 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port, Mark 1 to port and finish.

Course 3 is: start, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port, Mark 1 to port, Mark 2 to port and finish.

The course will be signaled with the display of the corresponding numeral pennant.

Marks 1 and 2 will be inflatable orange tetrahedrons.

See attached map for course location and configuration.

8. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing line will be between two yellow inflatable tetrahedrons.

9. TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be one and one-half hour for the first boat to finish.

10. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

Protests shall be delivered to WYC within 45 min. after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing at WYC.

11. SCORING

All scores will count. One race constitutes a series.

12. PRIZES

What we will have is an "End of Series" celebration beginning at 4:30.
