Appendix B Rose Bowl Regatta 2014 Parking, Trailer and Boat logistics

<u>Registration/Check In</u> – Registration/Check In will occur under the tent on the beach adjacent to the parking lot and beach launch area beginning at 8:30am on Saturday morning. Assuming all payments have been made online there will be minimal check in necessary. At check in you can: pick up pre-ordered t-shirts and/or purchase tshirts; purchase additional Saturday night dinners.

Boat Inspection – You must have your boat inspected before picking up your sails and prior to launching. Boat inspectors will be in the boat storage area on the beach with clip boards. They will complete an inspection form which you must take to the sail distribution location (in the parking lot where it opens to the beach storage area) to pick up your assigned sails.

Practicing – We will have safety boats available (coaches can share) and be conducting practice on Friday Jan. 3rd after 1pm beginning at the US Sailing Center moving out to the Pier and ending with all CFJ's on the beach between the Pier and the Olympic Pool. Dollies will be transported from the USSCLB to the beach on a flatbed trailer. Any "out-of-state" college teams that plan to practice on Friday should email <u>mikesego@ussclb.org</u> so a boat is reserved for you. Boats unclaimed at 3pm will be given to anyone.

Trailer Parking – Boats/Trailers arriving before noon on Friday Jan. 3rd should go to the US Sailing Center where boats can be launched and sailed around to the pier. We will transport dollies to the beach on Friday afternoon. From noon on Friday (Jan. 3rd) all boats will be launched and stored on the beach between the Belmont Pier and the Belmont Pool. Trailers will be stored in specially marked areas (see aerial photos) of the adjacent parking lot. Trailer parking (in the special zones) and boat parking (on the beach on dollies) is free for registered regatta participants. All boats and trailers must be removed from the Belmont parking lot and beaches by 7:00pm on Sunday Jan. 5th. There will be overnight security from 5pm to 7am on Friday and Saturday nights for boats on the beach and trailers in the parking lot. Please stay out of these areas during these hours to avoid confusion. Bring good wide tire dollies for beach launching!

<u>Car Parking</u> – Parking is available in the parking lot between the Belmont Pier and the Belmont Pool. ALL cars must pay to park from 8am – 6pm. The fee is \$.25 per 15 minutes (\$1 per hour) up to \$10 for the day. Payment may be made by cash or credit card. Make sure to pay for parking through 6pm. There is no charge after 6pm. Car Pooling is highly encouraged as parking is limited. Overflow parking is available on the south side of the Belmont Pool along the beach. This area is metered. Be careful of on-street parking near this area as most of it is 1 or 2 hour limited.

<u>Bathrooms</u> – There are bathrooms available in the Belmont Pool Building and at the end of the Pier.

<u>Trash</u> – We will have lots of trash cans on the beach, in the parking lot and on the Pier. It is vital that we use them and keep all of the areas that we use clean. Flagrant violations of this can result in protests!

<u>Pier Area Vendors</u> – There are three main vendors in close proximity to the Pier that are cooperating with us to host this event. They are: Belmont Brewery; La Palapa and Bouy's on the Pier. We encourage you to patronize these restaurants. There is a Vons Market, 7-Eleven, Jack in the Box and Chronic Tacos less than one block from the Pier.
