

NOTICE OF RACE 28th Annual Ice Bucket Regatta

January 4, 2014 (alternate date January 11, 2014)

The Ice Bucket Regatta is hosted by Lake Norman Yacht Club, Mooresville, North Carolina (www.lnyc.org)

In an effort to increase participation we are experimenting with changing the date to the first Saturday of the year and having a small party afterwards.

- 1. **Rules**: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (2013 2016), except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY**: This regatta is open to PHRF and one-design keelboats. A minimum of three boats shall constitute a class.
- 3. **ENTRY**: Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration form at Regatta Network http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/7587. Entry is not complete until payment is received.
- 4. **FEES**: \$30.00 per Boat (Includes one dinner)

US Sailing Members are discounted \$5.00

Late penalty (received after December 23, 2013) \$5.00

Dinner (Chili) \$6.00 per person (no advance purchase necessary)

- 6. **GENERAL INFORMATION**: Classes expected include Spinnaker, NonSpinnaker, Ultimate 20, J/24, J/70, Highlander, Flying Scot, San Juan 21.
- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be available at Check-In.
- 8. RACING AREA: The racing area will be on Lake Norman in close proximity to the Lake Norman Yacht Club.
- 9. **THE COURSES**: The courses to be sailed will be a combination of permanent lake marks and temporary marks, and will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 10. **Scoring**: All boats will be scored using PHRF Time on Distance, pursuit format. Low Point System; Appendix A2 of the racing rules will apply, except that all races will be scored with no throw outs Two races are scheduled. One race completed shall constitute a regatta. This changes RRS A2.
- 11. **Trophies**: Perpetual trophies (Ice Bucket and Dinghy Ice Bucket) will be presented to the top scoring keelboat and centerboard finishers. In addition, trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries in a class, as follows: 3 to 4 boats 1 trophy; 5 to 7 boats 2 trophies; 8 to 10 boats 3 trophies.
