1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the West Florida PHRF Class Rules, and applicable One Design Class Rules.

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all WFPHRF boats, Flying 10. Prizes Scot and other one design classes with three or more entries. WFPHRF Fleets include:

Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser 11. Disclaimer of Liability & Multi hull.

Fleets may be combined to constitute a class. Participants without current WFPHRF certificates will be given a rating and compete in one class called the Fun Fleet.

4. Registration & Fees

\$25 per boat for WFPRHF SBYA BOTY includes 12. Docking event cap. Saturday night pig roast dinner is an additional \$18.

5. Ratings and Class Rules

Boats sailing must have a valid WFPHRF certificate 13. Parking and have a copy of the certificate available. Rating certificates are available online at westfloridaphrf.org.

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

9. Scoring

9.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except no race will be excluded.

9.2 Buoy rating will be used for the windward-leeward dropped mark courses, and random leg rating used for all others.

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Participating boats may dock free of charge for the regatta from February 7^h thru 9th at the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

Parking is available for trailers and cars outside the main entrance. Vehicles parked blocking SSS members' boats will be towed.
